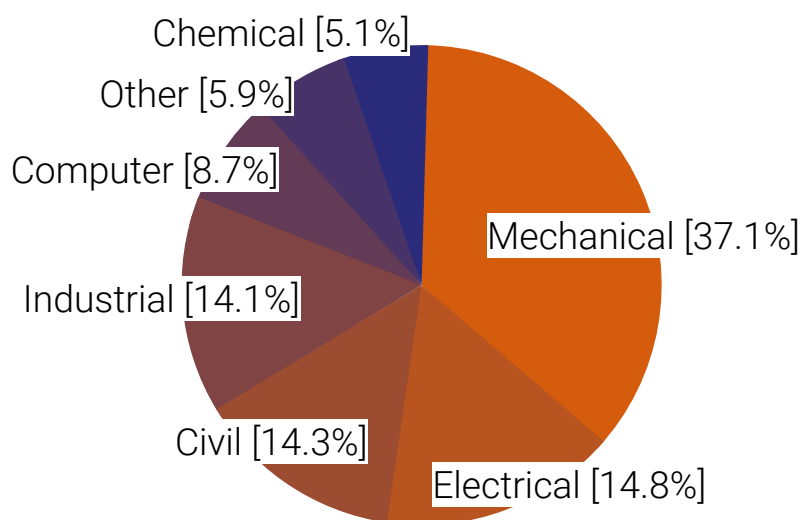

In 2020, the Engineering Games are thrust into a post-apocalyptic context where participants will have to change the world.

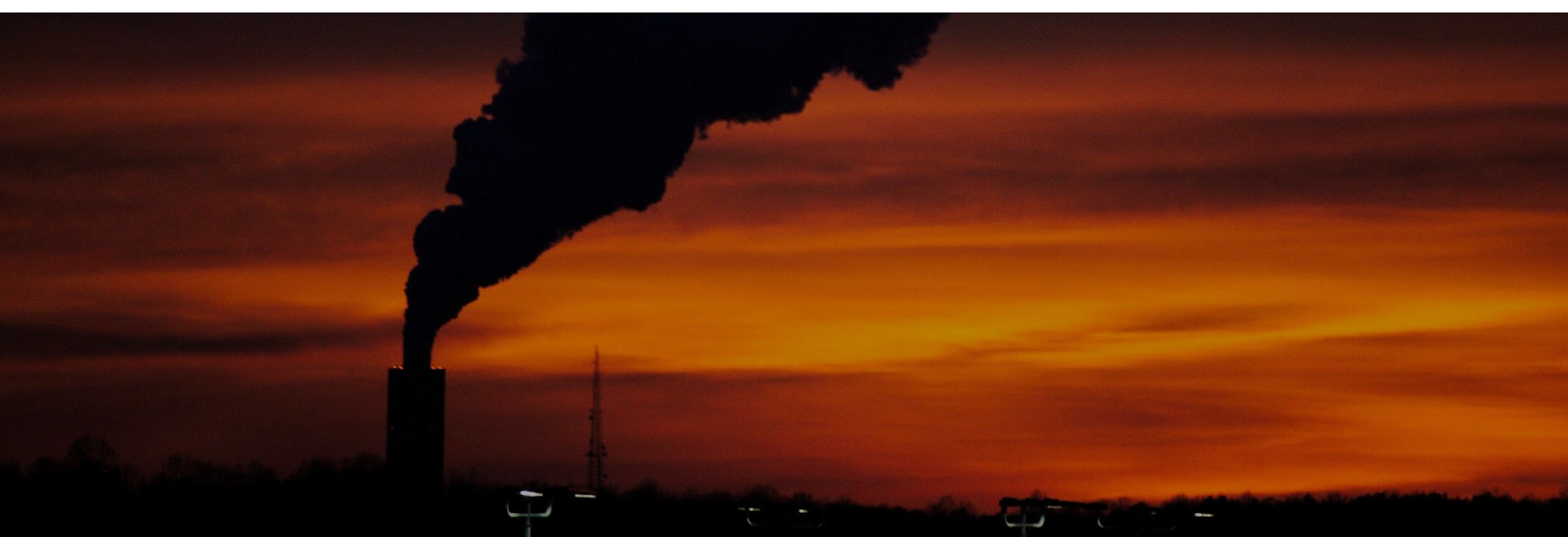
The climatologists of the **Bureau of Engineering and Planning of Multidisciplinary Official Competitions** (BEPCOM) ensure the imminent danger of a series of natural disasters that will have an alarmingly decimating impact toward life on Earth. These unprecedented events will begin in September 2019.

In view of **mission: JDG2020** which will take place next January, each Quebec university is mandated to select among their survivors 40 engineering students. This selection will be based on their ability to solve complex problems related to the reconstruction of a better, sustainable world in their image.

The purpose of this mission is to improve the living situation on Earth, to preserve our knowledge, to responsibly allocate our remaining resources, and to resume activities in a sustainable way.

- **La majeure**
A high complexity challenge realized over a very short period of time.
- **Academic Competitions**
Theoretical and practical exams covering multiple engineering disciplines.
- **Improvisation**
Theatrical improvisation competition
- **Engineering Consulting**
Resolution of a real world case presented to a jury.
- **Sports**
A full day of sport in a gym and even some more obscure sports.
- **Entrepreneurship**
Presentation of a marketing and business plan for a new technology
- **Oral Debates**
Teams reason their side while maintaining formal discourse and rhetoric.
- **Génie en herbe**
Tournament of general knowledge putting up teams of four vs four.
