CHARITY ACTIVITY

Each year, charity activities serve as an opportunity to give back to the community and demonstrate each delegation's commitment to a cause that is close to their hearts. This year, we encourage you to come together to carry out an initiative that makes an impact and showcases your creativity to make the world a better place.

For the charity activity assessment, here are the criteria that will be used for evaluation:

- Does my activity promote access to a service or good that usually has a financial barrier: food, organized activities, classes, etc.?
- Will I receive compensation for my activity: gift card, ticket, etc.? (If you participate in an activity related to food security and receive food, this compensation must be noted but will not be taken into account)
- Does the duration of the activity require me to adjust my schedule: an activity lasting several hours vs. one lasting less than an hour?
- Does my activity have an impact on the well-being of my community: happiness, accessibility, food security, etc.?



REPORT

To evaluate these criteria, you must submit a report containing the following details:

- The number of volunteering participants in each activity;
- The average number of hours contributed by each participant;
- Proof of completion of the activity (photos, videos, documents, emails, etc.);
- The location and date of your activity;
- A link to a post on your social media (if applicable);
- A brief explanation justifying your choice of activity and how it contributes to changing the world at your own scale.

Prioritize a clear, easy-to-read format that highlights the important information in your report.

It is important to note that only your main charity activity counts toward the majority of the score. Other activities will be factored into the participation percentage and the average number of hours per volunteering participant.



SCORING

FORMULA

Participation pourcentage * Hour/person rank * (accumulated points)

PARTICIPATION POURCENTAGE

This represents the number of participants from your delegation in charity activities divided by the total number of people in your delegation.

MULTIPLIERS

Participation Pourcentage

Total number of delegates
/Total number of participants

This represents the rank according to the table below:
